Welcome back to an action packed term 1!

This term our topic is The Romans.

As the name suggests, we will be learning how and when the Romans invaded, about their army, their home life other aspects of what it was like to live in Roman times.

This topic focuses on History, with a little Geography with both Art and DT linked in too. They will learn about what life is like in the Roman times, both for village people and for a Roman soldier.



In Science your child will be learning all about animals, including humans. We will be looking at our teeth and digestive systems, as well as looking at different animals and food chains in the wild. Different lessons will focus on various aspects - for example: Excuse me, are these your teeth? Who did this poo? Am I a predator?... We will find the answers to these and other peculiar questions about digestion and food chains.



We are continuing with our Spelling Bees this term - a list will come home shortly.

Please remember that we try to listen to your child read as often as possible. Your child needs to bring their book and reading record in a bag every day.

We are always happy to change books regularly, as long as the reading record has been signed to show that your child has read to an adult at home.

Our PE days are Tuesday and Wednesday.

PE is an essential part of the curriculum and every child should have a pair of shorts, a coloured t-shirt, a pair of tracksuit bottoms and a jumper in school as well as a change of shoes that can be used for both indoor and outdoor PE.



In PE we are doing dance and OAA (Outdoor and Adventurous Activities - this will focus on problem solving in a team).
