	<p>All children learn in different ways. If your child is struggling to learn, the pre-school may speak with you about they can help with this.</p>
	<p>The Pre-school will work with you and your child to put the right educational support in place but sometimes they need help from other people to be able to do this.</p>
	<p>LIFT is a meeting that pre-schools attend to talk about the needs of the children they are concerned about. A teacher leads the discussion to see how to support you and your child at Pre-school if they are making very little progress.</p>
	<p>To talk about your child's needs at the LIFT meeting the Pre-school will need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • your written consent • your email address or phone number
	<p>At the LIFT meeting different ways of helping your child to make progress could be suggested, including a visit from a Specialist Teacher.</p>
	<p>If it is decided that a Specialist Teacher might be able to help, they will visit the pre-school and meet with you and the SENCo and talk about how you and the pre-school can support your child.</p>
