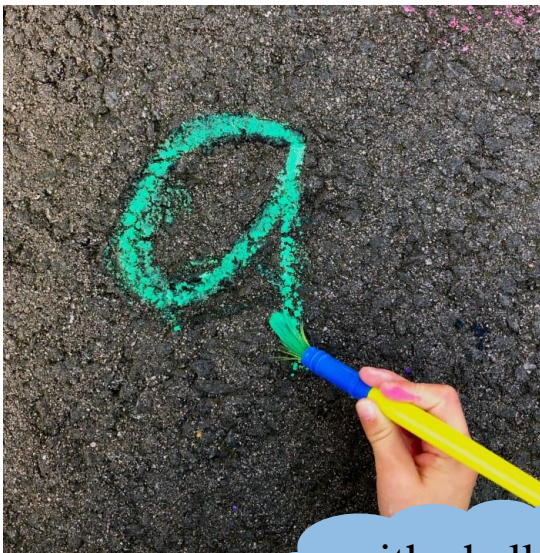


Writing Teen Numbers

We have been learning all about tricky teen numbers (numbers 11-19). Can you practise writing them at home? Here are some different ways that you could do it...



with chalk



in salt



in paint



in rice



with water

Remember to use the number rhymes to help you!

Make a big loop, just like so.
That is the way to make a zero!

A straight line and then we're done.
That's all you need for number 1.

Number 2 goes backwards and along.
Please make sure you don't go wrong!

2

Two little curls for number 3.
One for you, and one for me.

3

Number 4 goes down and across.
Give him a stick so he's the boss.

4

Number 5 is a funny chap.
Down, round fat tummy, and give him a hat!

5

Number 6 is like a curl in your hair.
Twirl it round so you know it's there.

6

Number 7 starts with a hat.
Then goes down just like that.

7

Make a S for number 8,
but don't forget to close the gate!

Number 9 is like a ball on a stick.
Do a C, and then up and down
quick.
