

Tuesday - maths word problems

1. Work out the answer to **6** divided by **2**.
2. Declan thinks that if you divide **2** by **6** you will get the same answer as if you divide **6** by **2**. Is he correct? Explain your answer.
3. Solve **40** divided by **10**.
4. Asmi has **10** cakes. She says she can share them between **20** friends and they will have **2** cakes each. Explain why she is not correct.
5. Farmer Joe has **12** cows. He shares the cows equally into **10** fields. How many cows are in each field?
6. There are **6** cakes. How many people can have **2** cakes each?
7. The baker puts **2** iced flowers on each cake. She uses **16** iced flowers. How many cakes has she baked?

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CHALLENGE

- a. Asmi, Mia, Sam, Harry and Declan buy some sweets to share.

The sweets come in packets of **14**, **15** or **16**.

Which size packet should the children buy so that they can share the sweets equally?

- b. Year 1 and Year 2 are going to take part in some races.

There are **48** children altogether in Year 1 and Year 2.

- i) How many teams of **2** can take part in the 3-legged race?
- ii) Only **4** teams can race at a time.
How many 3-legged races will there need to be?
