
English

Our first unit in English will be based on 'There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom' by Louis Sachar. In this book, we will follow the life of Bradley
Chalkers - his troubles and eventual transformation when he finds a friend. This story will encourage the children to reflect on the character's feelings and debate his actions and motives. You could use questions about the character's feelings when reading at home this

term.

We will also be learning to write biographies. We will read about famous musicians, inspiring scientists and sportsmen and women. You could discuss the different types of punctuation found in your child's reading book.

Please encourage your children to check out some of Louis Sachar's other books: Holes and Fuzzy Mud.



Our area for study this term is The Circulatory System.

We will be dissecting a heart, making blood and researching facts about William Harvey. We will be investigating our pulse rate and how it is affected by exercise. We will learn about the effects of exercise, drugs and alcohol on our bodies. We will explore the importance of healthy eating and will design a savoury snack (pasta) based on our learning. Your child could take part in cooking at home to further develop skills like cutting, grating and

measuring ingredients.



This term, the children will be continuing to deepen their understanding of place value and our number system. We will learn to read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10 000 000 and determine the value of each digit. We will build on our prior learning and use negative numbers in a variety of contexts, and calculate intervals across zero. Throughout this topic, we will solve number and practical problems to strengthen our understanding. During topic maths, we will continue to explore conversions of measures. We will learn how to convert units of length, mass and volume and will learn how to convert between miles and kilometres. Please ensure that your child has a rapid recall of times table facts. TTRS is a fantastic online tool to support

this.
