information with you

- ★ Parents will also be kept up to date termly with progress through Spelling and Times Tables.

Term 1

- ★ Welcome Meetings for all classes – information shared about the curriculum, trips, homework expectations, opportunities for parental involvement, behaviour policy, merit system, statutory testing and year 6 residential.
- ★ Phonics meeting for Reception parents – find out how we teach phonics and how parents can support reading at home.

Term 2

- ★ Parent Consultations – opportunity to discuss your child's progress, how they have settled into their new class and to discuss any concerns that you may have. There will be two evening sessions but if these times are not convenient alternative appointments can be arranged directly with your child's class teacher. Opportunity to speak to SENDCo / Headteacher if required. Nursery meetings will be held during the school day with your child's Key Worker.
- ★ Phonics meeting for Year 1 parents – find out how the Little Wandle scheme progresses into year 1 and how parents can support reading at home.

Term 3

- ★ Year 4 PSHE information sharing and meeting with parents – find out what the children will be learning through the Term 4 PSHE curriculum 'How will we grow and change'.
- ★ Year 4 Multiplication Check – information shared with parents about the test and the benefits for the children in being fluent with their times tables.

Term 4

- ★ Parent Consultations – opportunity to discuss your child's progress. There will be two evening sessions but if these times are not convenient alternative appointments can be arranged directly with your child's class teacher. Opportunity to speak to SENDCo / Headteacher if required. Nursery meetings will be held during the school day with your child's Key Worker.
- ★ Statutory testing meeting for Year 6 parents – find out when and how the tests will be delivered and how parents can support their children to be ready for SATS week.

Term 5

- ★ Meeting for Year 1 parents – find out when and how the Phonics screening check will be carried out and how parents can further support reading at home.
- ★ Year 6 PSHE information sharing and meeting with parents – find out what the children will be learning through the Term 6 PSHE curriculum 'What will change as we become more independent?'

Term 6

- ★ Class drop-ins / meet the teacher – have an informal chat with your child's current class teacher and meet your child's new teacher for the new academic year.
- ★ Transition meeting for new parents joining Reception and Nursery.
- ★ Annual reports are sent home to parents.
