Literacy	<p>We have been reading Room on the Broom by Julia Donaldson. You can watch it here: https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/p0102qfj/room-on-the-broom</p> <p>Could you retell the story to someone at home? Maybe you could make some props like a wand, a yellow bow or a witch's hat or some puppets of the characters to help you retell the story.</p>
Maths	<p>Our number of the week is number 3. Can you use objects from around the house and put them into groups of 3? Remember to count carefully as you count out the correct amount. Once you have done this, you could do the same with a different number? Understanding the world	<p>On Sunday, we celebrate Bonfire Night. This is a special night where we go and watch fireworks. Can you create a firework picture with your adult at home? You could use chalks, felt tips, colouring pencils or even playdough or other 3D objects to make firework shapes. There are some suggestions below.</p> <p>You could also watch a firework display with your adults at home. Listen to the noises and watch the colours. How do they make you feel? Physical development	<p>Yoga is a good way to keep fit and to relax. It can help you feel like the green and yellow colour monster! Can you do the Halloween Cosmic yoga with Jamie: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=LCVengYJHss</p> <p>Afterwards you could find another way to make you feel happy or calm such as looking at a book, doing some colouring or building with lego. Expressive arts and design	On Tuesday, we celebrated Halloween. Could you draw a picture of what you were dressed up as? You might want to change your costume to something different! Remember to use a wide range of colours to make yourself look scary and spooky!
Phonics	We have learnt the sounds: b, h, ll and ss. Go on a phonics hunt. What objects can you find that have those sounds in them? <i>For example: bus, hair, doll, dress.</i> You can also practise writing: b, h, ll and ss.
