Battling for Britain

In this fascinating topic, the children are going to be learning about who the Jutes, Angles and Saxons were, where they came from and where they settled. In number maths this term we will be focussing on addition and subtraction. This will include adding and subtracting numbers mentally and adding and subtracting numbers with up to 3 digits by using formal written methods.

In topic maths, we will be learning about perimeter. This will include using a ruler accurately to measure different lines using cm, mm and m, finding the circumference using string and exploring the perimeter of different 2D shapes.
