New research shows the different number of words children will have heard by age 5 based on how often parents read to them:



Never read to: 4,662 words

1-2 times per week: 63,570 words

3-5 times per week: 169,520 words

Daily: 296,660 words

Five books a day: 1,483,300 words

Reading is a skill that is critical for succeeding in most subjects.

Reading books leads to a higher general intelligence. Research shows 20 mins a day can develop critical thinking skills. Reading for pleasure is more important for children's development than their parents' level of education and is a more powerful factor in lifelong achievement than their socio-economic background.
