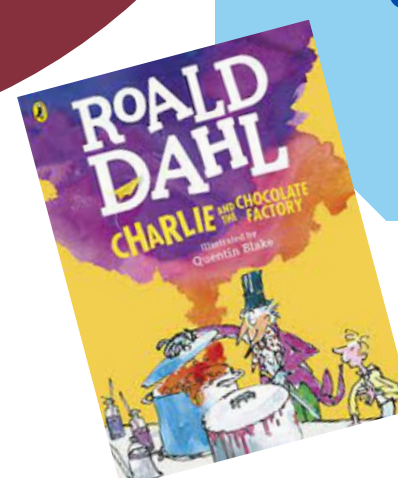


PE

Maths

In number maths this term we will be focusing on fractions. We will be; counting up in tenths, recognising unit and non-unit fractions, recognising and showing equivalent fractions and adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominators.

In topic maths, we will be; recognising pairs of perpendicular and parallel lines, recognising horizontal and vertical lines and exploring angles.

English

This term in English, we are looking at the story of 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' by Roald Dahl and writing our own stories based on this. We will also be exploring play scripts and adapting an extract of the story into a play script. Our non-fiction learning this term is based around instructions and recipes.
