Term 5

Stone Age to Iron Age

This term we will be historians, learning about the Stone Age to Iron Age. We will learn how artefacts help us uncover mysteries of the past and we will consider whether we are still reliant on the natural materials around us to enrich our lives today. We will discuss and explore; how the pre-historic era has impacted our life today? And was the change from a nomadic existence to becoming settled a necessary one? As Geographers, we will consider the areas of their settlement as well as designing homes as if Dover was the area of our own settlement. Finally, as artists, using the style of cave paintings, we will consider; how does Art speak to people? And can we use Art to tell a story?

Maths

In number maths this term we will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction. We will be recapping and enhancing our learning from Terms 1 and 2.

In topic maths, we will be exploring capacity, volume and mass.

We will also be continuing to work on the 3, 4 and 8 times table, and the corresponding division facts. Please work on these with your child at home.

Reminders

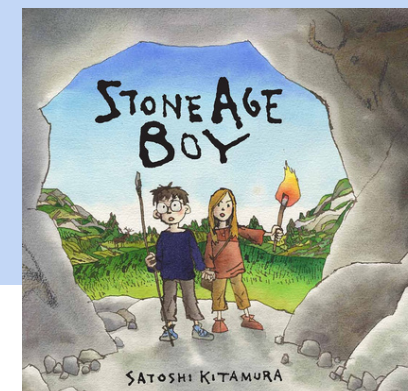
