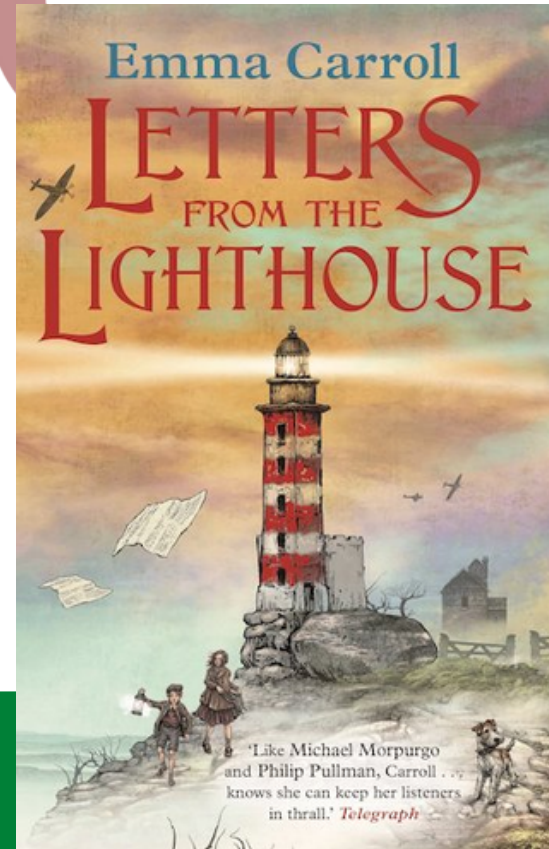
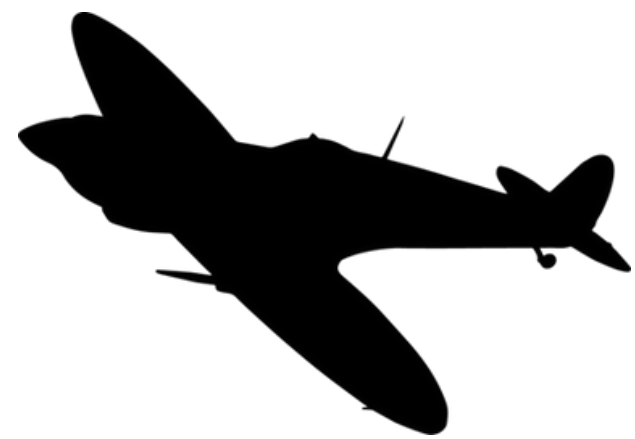


WORLD WAR II

Creative Curriculum

Our history learning will lead us to investigate why World War Two started and the chronology and impact of the War, with a focus upon the role of Dover. From our special Evacuation Day, we will continue to view the war through the eyes of our alter-ego evacuees. The children's skills in history, geography and art will be developed in our study of World War II as we find out about the Battle of Britain and what life was like for children during the war.

Maths We will begin by measuring angles with protractors before moving to calculating missing angles on straight lines, in triangles and in quadrilaterals. Following this, we will be using our calculation skills to solve algebra problems. We will frequently revisit previously taught skills and understanding through our regular arithmetic practice. Please ensure your child to play on Times Table Rockstars as much as possible to improve their rapid recall.

PE

In PE this term, the children will be taught by our Sports Coach every Friday, developing their games skills. Please make sure your child has their PE kit in school on this day. As many lessons will be held outside, please ensure children have a warm tracksuit and trainers as part of their PE kit.
