We make rules clear to everyone. We speak kindly.

Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes and to have their views considered and taken seriously. Children have the right to share freely what they learn, think and feel, by talking, drawing, writing or in any other way unless it harms other people. Children can choose their own thoughts, opinions and religion but this should not stop other people from enjoying their rights.

Adults will be led by children's interests when choosing activites or zones. Adults on the playground will listen to all children involved in incidents or disputes.

We tidy all equipment away and share with others.



Children have the right to get information from the internet, radio, television, newspapers and books.

Adults will provide a range of engaging books for the quiet area.

We are gentle and play noncontact games. We stay in the correct zone and are mindful of others around us.



Children have the right to be protected from violence, abuse and being neglected by anyone who looks after them.

Adults will monitor the zones and activities for safe play. Adults will use the behaviour ladders rules.

We make playtime fun by being positive and showing kindness. Everyone can join in.
