Maths

This term in maths, we are focusing on multiplication and division. We are learning how to use a range of strategies to multiply and divide numbers. We are also going to be learning about money. We will be applying our previously taught addition and subtraction methods to help us solve money related questions.

Reading

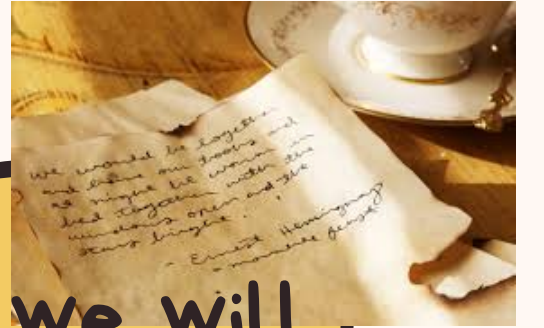

Regular reading is critical for developing the children's writing skills and will support your child through the entirety of their school journey.

PE

Our PE lesson will continue to be on Tuesdays this term. Please ensure that your child's PE kit is always in school and earrings are taken out, otherwise they are unable to join in.

English

In English this term, we will be using our topic as a hook for our writing. We will be using a fiction and non-fiction book, based on The Great Fire of London to inspire the children to practice writing in variety of styles. We will be writing a fact file, a non-chronological report, an explanation text and even a diary entry inspired by Samuel Pepys!



Topic

This term, we're becoming hard-working historians and journeying back to 1666 to explore The Great Fire of London! We'll discover how the devastating fire spread through the city and destroyed thousands of houses and buildings. We will learn how London was rebuilt, focusing on the impact the event has had on our lives today. As ambitious artists, we'll also develop sketching skills and use charcoal to recreate dramatic scenes from this historical event.
