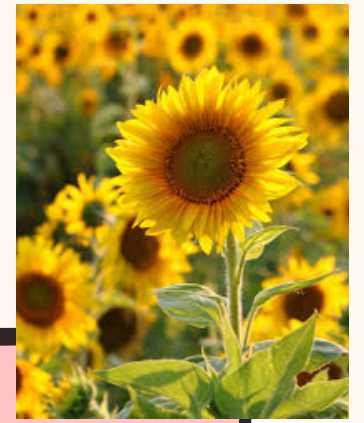




GREEN CLASS TERM 4 NEWSLETTER



Maths

In maths this term, we will be continuing our learning on multiplication and division. We will then begin to explore a range of measurements; experimenting with measuring using standard units. To support your child at home please encourage them to measure different objects at home. This could be weighing ingredients when cooking or measuring liquids themselves.

Topic

Our topic this term is the, 'Garden of England'. As spectacular scientists we will consider conditions plants need to grow and experiment with this by growing cress in different conditions. We will also be growing our own bean plants and documenting the journey of this. Then, as great geographers we will carry out our own fieldwork studies and present what we discover. We will end this terms topic work by making our own bird feeders as a design and technology project.

Our learning this term will be linked to our creative curriculum topic. Our class text is the 'Tale of Peter Rabbit'. We will use this text to inspire our own adventure stories. We will then be focusing on non fiction texts, looking at a variety of instructional writing. We will then be writing our own instructions on how to plant a seed.
