## Key Vocabulary -

**Reversible change** - a change in materials that can be changed back to their original condition.

**Irreversible change** - a change in materials that cannot be changed back. **Solution** - a liquid with another material mixed in. **Solvent** - the main liquid in a solution. **Solute** - the material mixes into a solvent. **Soluble** - a material that is able to dissolve. **Insoluble** - a material that is unable to dissolve.
