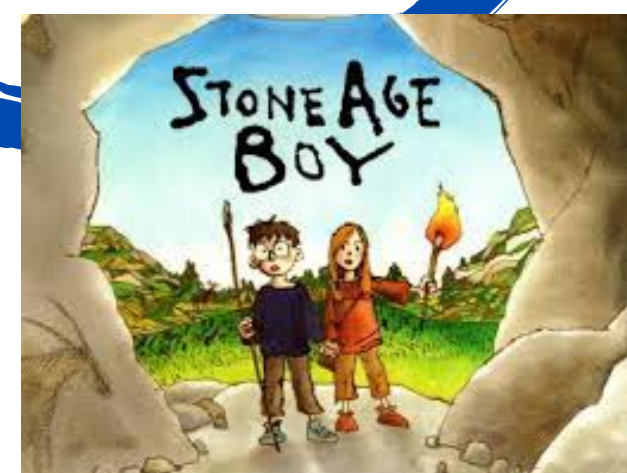
Stone Age to Iron Age

Our topic this term is 'Stone Age to Iron Age'. Whilst exploring the lives of the pre-historic, we will become aware as historians of how artefacts help us uncover mysteries of the past. Knowledge and understanding about the Stone Age transition from hunter gatherers to farmers will enable us to consider whether we are still reliant on the natural materials around us today to enrich our lives. As Geographers, we will consider the areas of their settlement as well as designing homes as if Dover was the area of our settlement. Using the style of cave paintings, we will consider, 'How does Art speak to people?', 'and Can we use Art to tell a story?'



English

This term we will be exploring the book 'Stone Age Boy'. We will use the story as inspiration to write diary entries and descriptive narratives, focusing on adding detail and using descriptive vocabulary. We will also focus on organising ideas into paragraphs whilst continuing to develop spelling, punctuation and grammar skills.



Maths

This term in maths, pupils will further develop their understanding of fractions alongside learning about money. They will explore how to add and subtract fractions and calculate fractions of amounts. Additionally, pupils will strengthen their understanding of money by adding and subtracting amounts and working out change.
