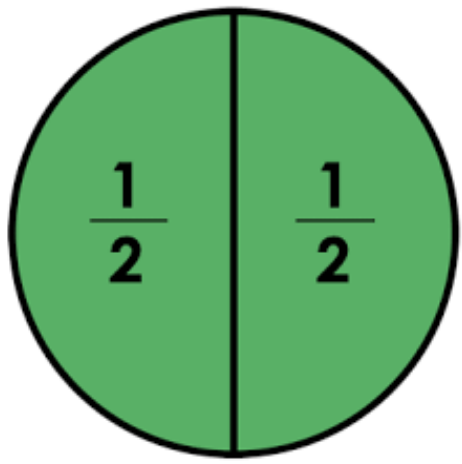

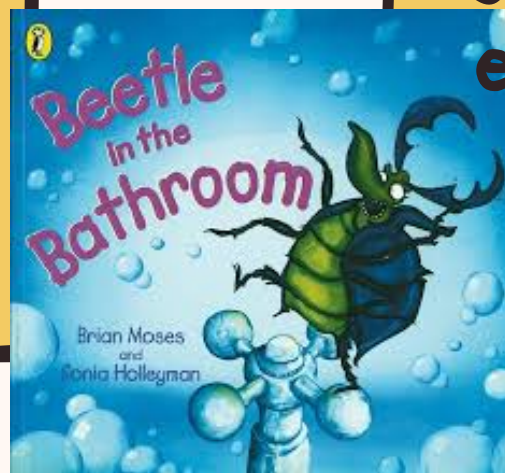


Maths

In maths this term, we are excited to be exploring fractions. We will learn how to divide shapes and quantities into equal parts. Children will learn how to identify and create simple fractions like, halves, quarters and thirds, using everyday objects. We encourage parents to support their child by discussing fractions at home, whether it's sharing a pizza or dividing up snacks!

English

In English, our class text is *Beetle in the Bathroom*. We will use this fun and engaging text to inspire our own rhyming poems, exploring rhyme, rhythm, and playful language. As the term progresses, we will link our English work to our topic by using our knowledge of minibeasts to write a fact files about bugs.



Topic

This term, Year 2 will be learning about Bugs and Beasties. We will explore how living things grow and change, including life cycles, and learn about different habitats and what animals need to survive. As part of our Geography work, we will investigate minibeasts around the school, using simple maps and directional language during our outdoor fieldwork. We will collect simple data and talk about where bugs are most commonly found. The children will also share their findings and explain what makes a good habitat.
