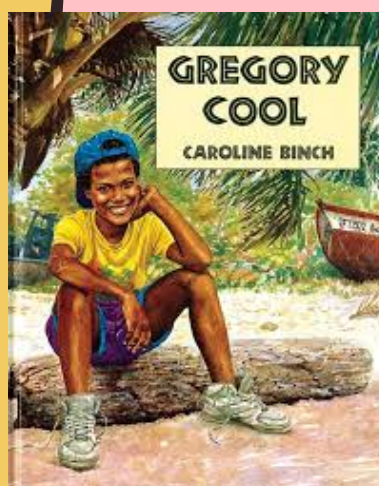


Maths

In maths this term, we are excited to be learning all about time! The children will be learning to tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past, quarter to and half past. Please support your child by encouraging them to read clocks and talk about time throughout the day. Towards the end of the term, we will also be learning about statistics and position and direction, including representing data, using pictograms and tally charts, and exploring positional language.

English

Our learning this term will be linked to our creative curriculum topic. Our class text is 'Gregory Cool'. This exciting text is set in Tobago and follows the story of a young boy discovering the beauty and vibrancy of the country. We will use this text to inspire writing our own letters and postcards. We will then be focusing on non-fiction texts, combining our topic learning to make our writing both informative and descriptive.



Topic

All aboard, Year 2! In our topic learning this term, we will be exploring the question, 'How big is the world?'. The children will learn about the seven continents and five oceans as we journey on a virtual cruise around the world, visiting different countries and major cities along the way. We will explore celebrations, cultures and geographical features making comparisons between places. We will also be working as an Aspirational Artist using inspiration from different countries to create colourful artwork and replicas of cultural emblems.
