

Term 6

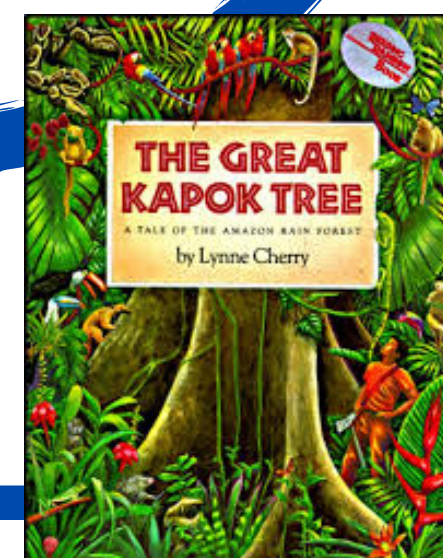
The Enchanted Wood and Light

Our topic this term is 'The Enchanted Wood and Light'. We will begin to understand what plants need to survive, the life cycle of plants, where light comes from and how it reflects off different surfaces. We will learn about this through using torches in dark areas and investigating which environments are the best conditions for plants to grow.

We will finish off the term by looking at the artwork of Rebecca Vincent and replicating this artwork on to canvases as a final piece.

English

This term we will be exploring the book 'The Great Kapok Tree'. We will use the story as inspiration to write setting descriptions, focusing on adding detail and using descriptive vocabulary. We will also write a persuasive letter based on saving our rainforests, making sure to include rhetorical questions and emotive language to gauge the readers attention.



Maths

This term in maths, pupils will further develop their understanding of time alongside learning about shape. They will explore how to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes and how to use A.M and P.M. Additionally, pupils will strengthen their understanding of shape by looking at different angles and using this to draw a range of polygons.

Reminders

Home learning will be set on Purple Mash every Friday; this will consist of one spelling activity alongside a math task based on our current or previous topic.
