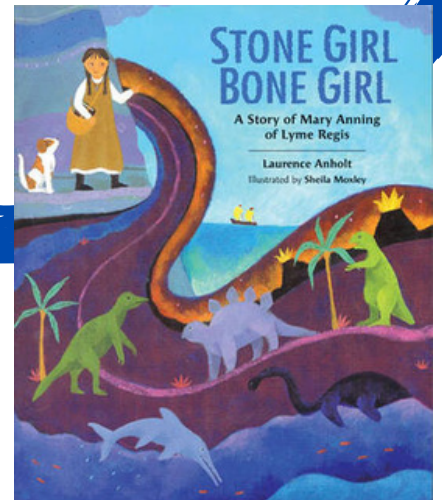
Extreme Environments

Our topic this term is 'Extreme Environments'. In this fascinating topic the children will learn how volcanoes and mountains are formed, as well as how earthquakes come to happen. We will be exploring what rocks and fossils are and looking at how the environment has changed over time. The children will learn about the earth and how it is made and where volcanoes are around the world. We will develop our science skills by conducting investigations on rocks and soils. As amazing artists, we will develop our use of sketch books and consider how these can support us in refining our observational and sketching skills.



English

We will be looking at the text Stone Girl Bone Girl in order to improve our writing skills and vocabulary. We will be making links with our topic and creating our own version of the story. We will also begin our non-fiction unit by looking at recounts.



Maths

In Number Maths, we're learning all about place value; comparing, ordering, estimating, reading and writing numbers in numerals and words.
