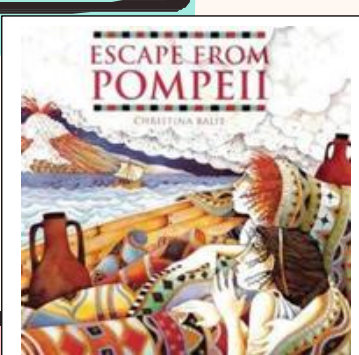
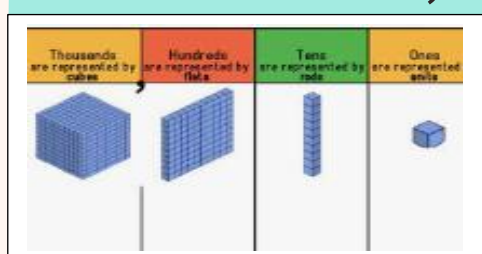


STANTON CLASS
