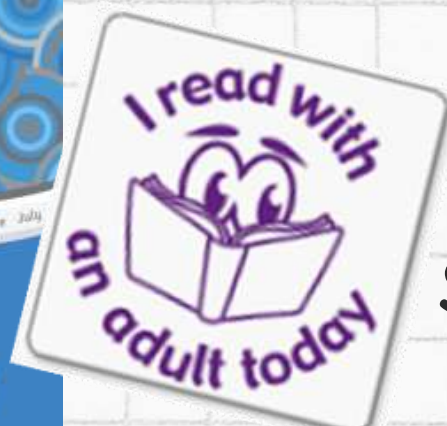

Reading at home

Children are encouraged to read at least 3 times a week and their reading records are checked to see if an adult at home has counter-signed. When an adult in school listens to a child read, their reading record will be stamped so parents can see when their child has been heard.

Home Learning



Children will be assigned 2 tasks each week to complete on Purple Mash. Feedback will be given on Purple Mash.



Children will be expected to complete 20 minutes on TTRS each week.

Weekly spellings: Weekly spellings will be sent home in your child's reading record. They should learn these at home ready to use them in the classroom. In Year 4, we will have a weekly spelling test every Friday.

Multiplication Test

In Term 6 children will sit a multiplication test. It is an online one and there are 25 random questions. Completing the studio on TTRS will help as well as Mathsframe. It is in the style of the test.
