Lots of eyes?



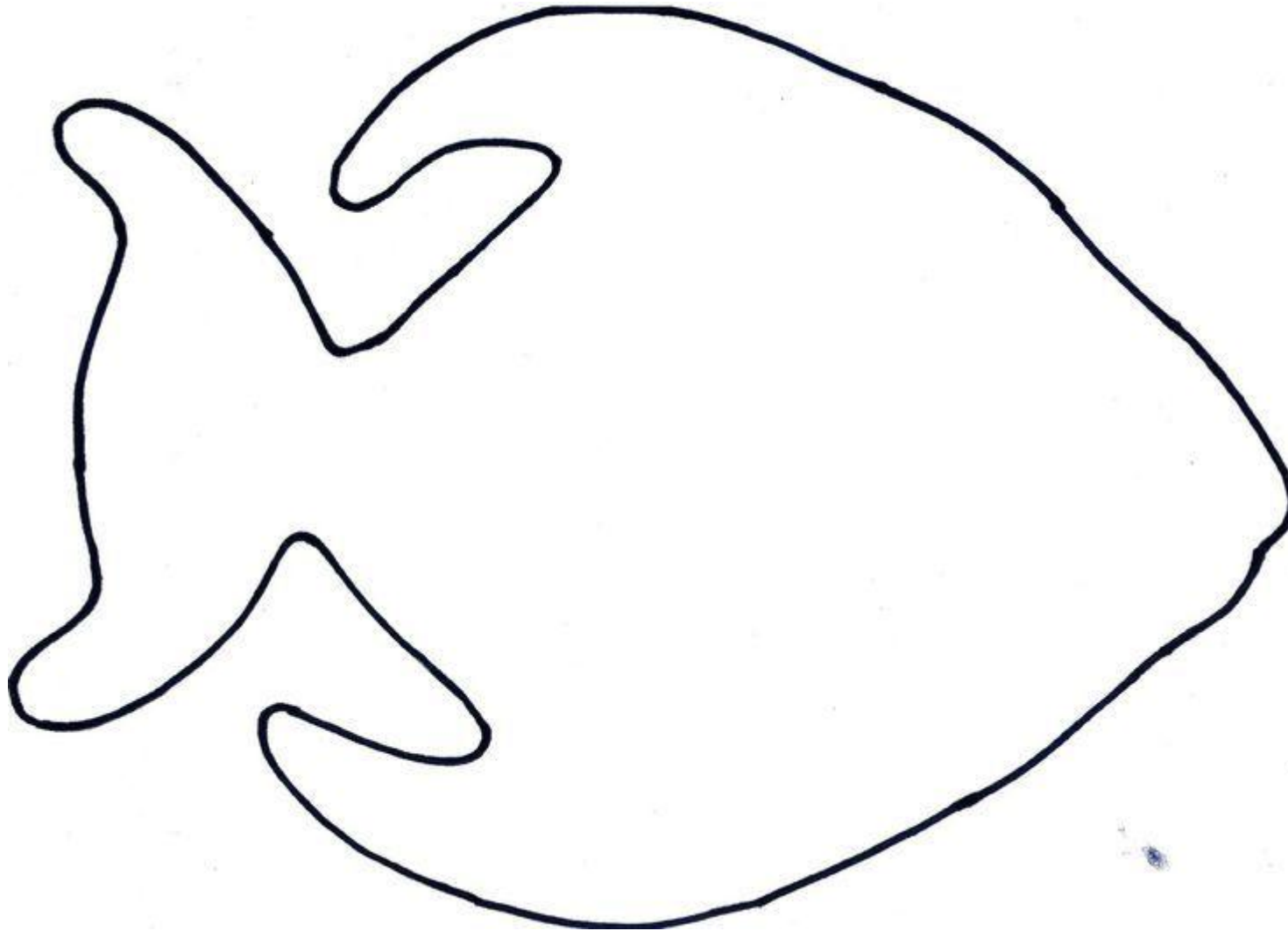

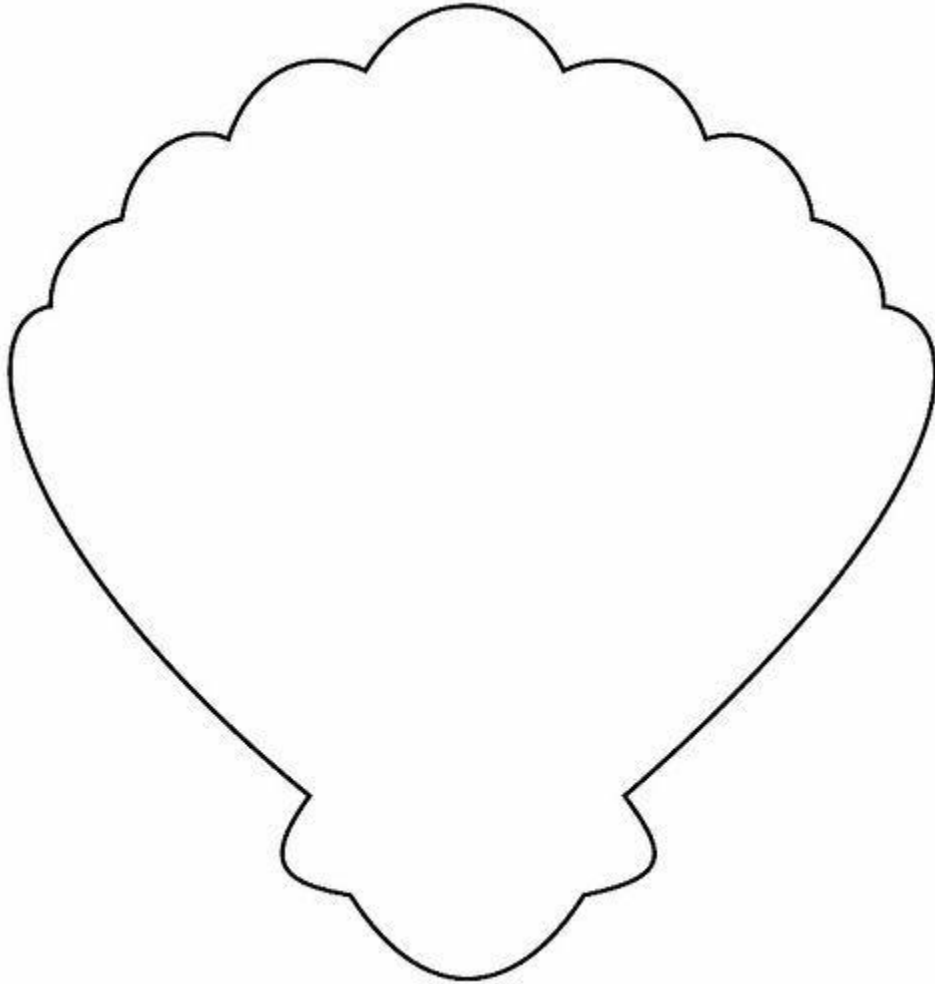
