

## How to care for a Doxy

In the event of capturing a Doxy, it is essential you follow these vital instructions...

1. When you first spot a Doxy, try as carefully as you can not to alarm it; it does not respond well to loud noises. Often, when startled, Doxies have been known to scratch every inch of its victims' skin with the sharpened claws on its many limbs.
  2. Without damaging its delicate wings, capture the Doxy in a fine mesh net and securely contain the creature in a large bell bottle jar (which are currently only available from the Tic Tac Toe shop.) Add native foliage to the jar along with strips of a variety of fabrics for its nest and store the jar in a warm dry place out of direct sunlight.
  3. To ensure that a Doxy does not lose her wings, it is essential to give three drops of pinkice oil a day. Unfortunately, this dark chalky medicine is not palatable for the Doxy and must be secreted within its daily supply of fresh Mauvet Mountain dew.
  4. Although a Doxy is small creature, it has a mighty appetite; regularly feed this ravenous creature 7 times a day on an ample diet of dandelions and daisies. The daisies must have the storks completely removed as Doxies tend to react to them in quite a peculiar way.
  5. Finally, encourage the Doxy to take at least nine 4-minute naps a day. To establish a successful naptime routine, cover the Doxy's jar with a thick black cloth (preferably wool as it blocks out the light) whilst simultaneously playing soothing morning calls of the high pitched Warbler. Generally, a Doxy does not require too much sleep however if they do not stick to their naps, they have a tendency to become quite aggressive and may bite.
- If bitten, seek immediate medical attention and place a silk cloth over the wound until seen by a doctor to administer the carolflak poultice.
