












Year R Home Learning (Amazing Animals)

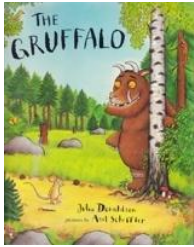
This sheet contains suggested activities for Home Learning this week. It is not an expectation that all activities are completed.

It might be *The Gruffalo* or *Elmer!*

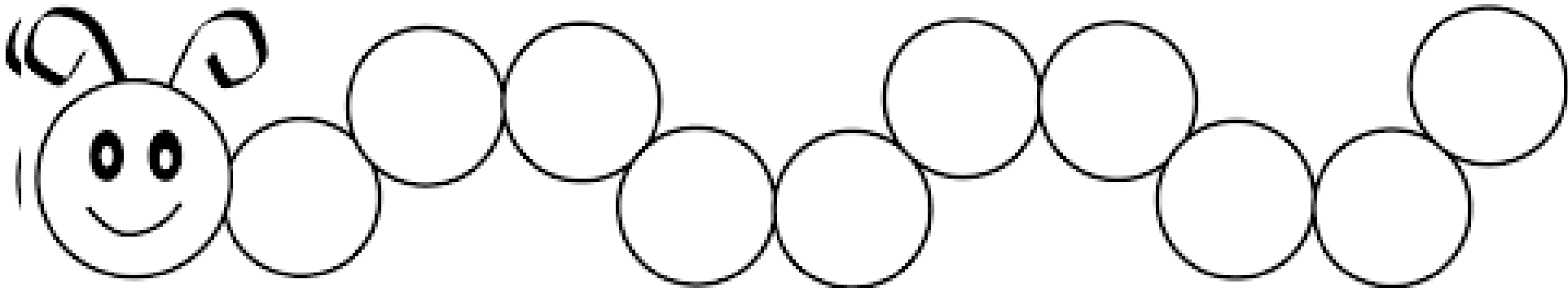
Use a magazine to find some of your favourite things. Cut them out and stick them on a page to share with your new teacher.
